



Mentor a Child License Plate Renewal Instructions

Follow these steps if you need to renew your Mentor a Child plate.

Step 1

Visit <https://myweb.in.gov/BMV/mybmv/Default.aspx> and sign in to your myBMV account.

If you don't have one, registering for one is easy and takes only seconds—you just provide your driver's license number, the last 4 digits of your social security number, and your zip code.

That's it! (You may also renew your registrations without an account at the bottom of the same page.)



Step 2

Once you've signed in, select the first option: "Renew license plates."

Beginning on **January 1, 2012**, you will be able to return to your myBMV account and renew your plate, **even if your renewal date is still months away.**)
